The hotel was inaugurated in October 1958, during President Kubitschek's term as head of Brazilian government. He ordered that the hotel should be painted in pink, and we keep the same colour and tradition until today.

In many ways it has become the ultimate South American celebrity hideaway.

Superior Rooms (74) Approximately 20m² (215ft²) with shower or bathtub. 1 queen or twin beds, views towards the forest or to the garden. Connect to another Superior Room.

Deluxe Falls View Room - Twin Beds (8) Approximately 25m² (270ft²) exclusive views towards the Iguassu falls, bathrooms with twin vanity units, bathtub or walk-in shower.

Junior Suites - Queen Bed (9) Approximately 30m² (377ft²) small living room with a writing desk, bathroom with shower or bathtub with twin vanity units, 1 king or two single beds, DVD, coffee machine and kettle. View to the forest or garden. Connect to a Superior Room or Cataratas Suite.

Junior Suites - Twin Beds (8) Approximately 30m² (377ft²) small living room with a writing desk, bathroom with shower or bathtub with twin vanity units, 1 king or two single beds, DVD, coffee machine and kettle. View to the forest or garden. Connect to a Superior Room or Cataratas Suite.

Cataratas Junior Suite (1) Approximately 40m² (430ft²), small living room with a writing desk, bathroom with shower and bathtub, twin vanity units, king bed DVD, coffee machine and kettle. These suites enjoy views of the Falls. Can connect to Cataratas Suite.

Noble Suite (1) Approximately 42m² (678 ft²) living room, bathroom features a shower and bathtub and one vanity unit. 1 king bed, DVD player, view towards the garden.

Master Suite (3) Approximately 40m² (484 ft²) separated living room, 2 TVs, bathroom features a shower and bathtub and one vanity unit. 1 king bed, DVD player, view towards the forest, pool or garden.

Terrace Suite (1) Approximately 50m² (710ft²) views of the forest from a large balcony, living room, king size bed, bath tub and shower, twin vanity units, DVD, coffee machine and kettle.

Pool Suite (2) Approximately 42m² (452ft²), small living room with a writing desk, Sofa bed, bathroom with shower and bathtub, twin vanity units, king bed, private pool and garden, DVD player, Coffee machine and kettle, Walk in closet, view over a private garden.

Tower Suite (1) Approximately 51 m² (689ft²), large living room, bathroom with shower and bathtub, twin vanity units, 1 king bed, coffee machine and kettle, DVD player, 2 TVs, walk in Closet, partial view of the waterfalls, located in the main building.

Deluxe Suite (1) Approximately 64m² (904ft²). One bedroom suite with king size bed and delightful views of the forest. Large private living room with a dining room for up to six people, bath tub and walk-in shower, twin vanity units, DVD player, Coffee machine and kettle, 2 TVs. This suite can connect with a Junior Suite.

Cataratas Suite (1) Approximately 64m² (904ft²). One bedroom suite with a king size bed, delightful view towards the waterfalls, large living room with a dining room for up to six people. Bathtub and walk-in shower, twin vanity units, DVD player, Coffee machine and kettle, 2 TVs. This suite can connect with a Junior Suite and to Cataratas Junior Suite.


