A Grammy Award winner Purple Disco Machine has had huge success with his own multi-platinum hit records and with multiple high-profile remixes for the likes of Dua Lipa, Mark Ronson, Foals, Calvin Harris, Sir Elton John & Britney Spears, Fatboy Slim, Lady Gaga & Ariana Grande.
